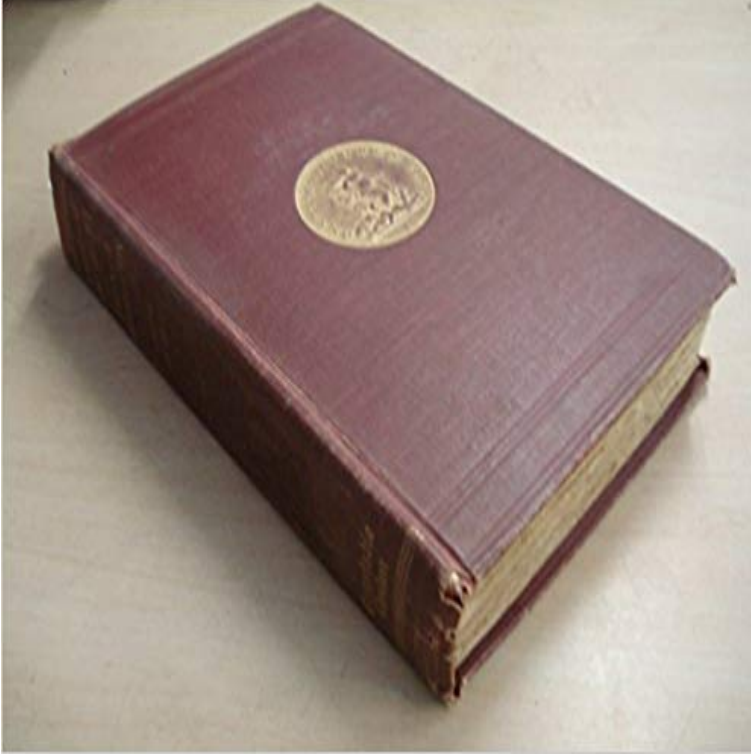


Catherine De Medici and the French Reformation,
