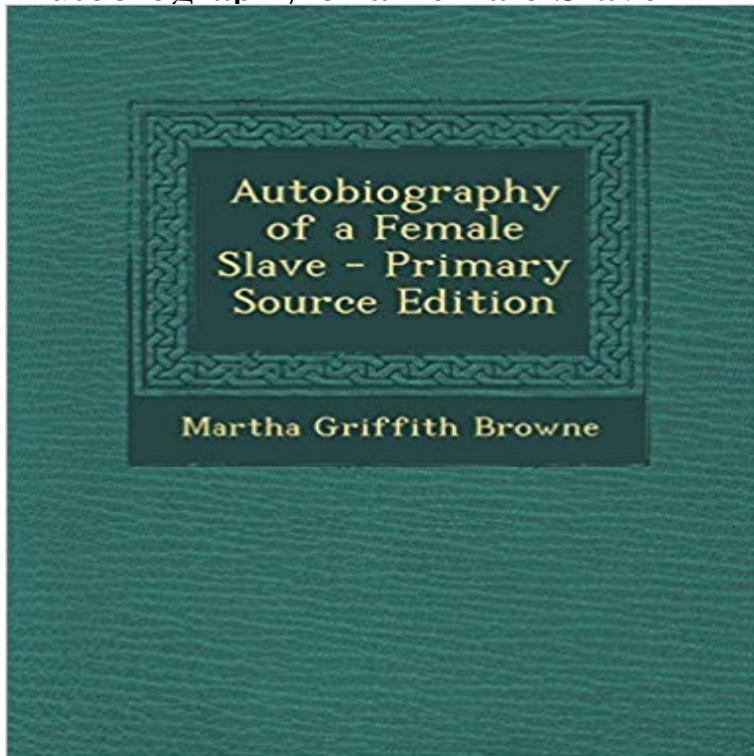


## Autobiography of a Female Slave
