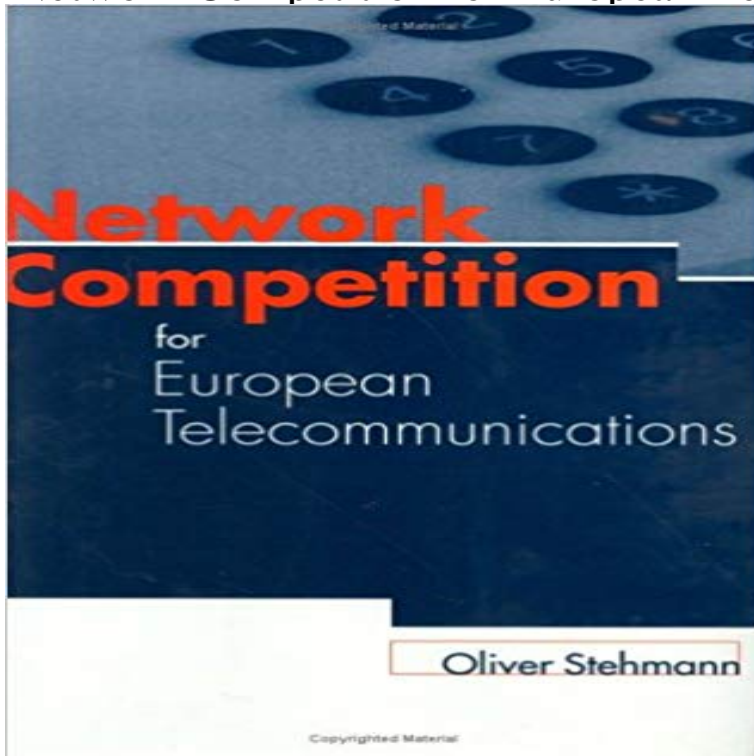


Network Competition for European Telecommunications
