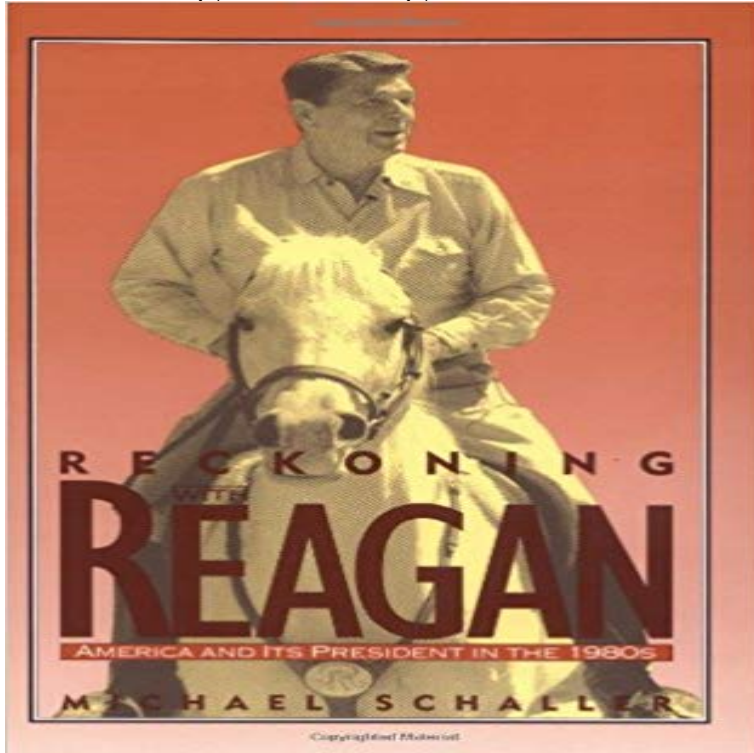


## Reckoning with Reagan: America and Its President in the 1980s
