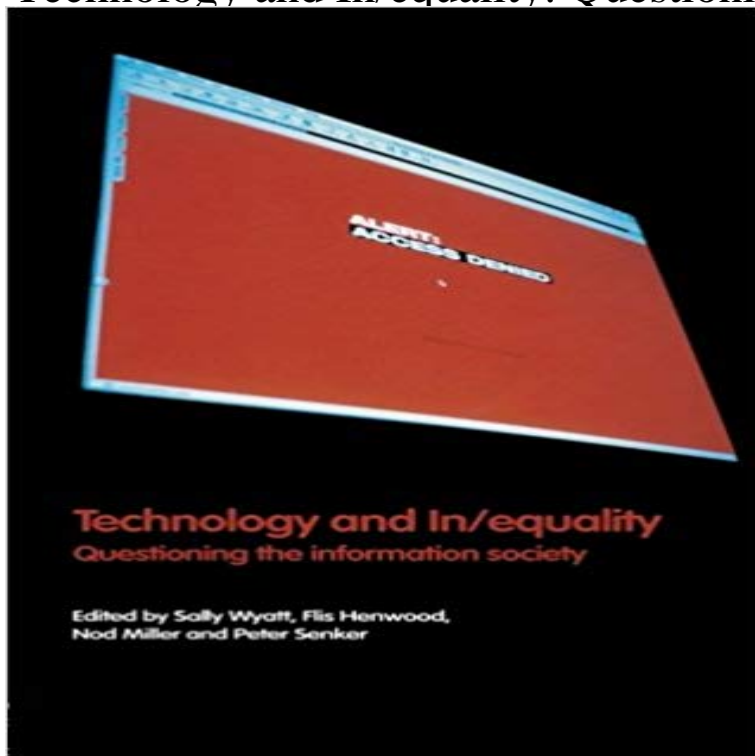


# Technology and In/equality: Questioning the Information Society
