
The Nelson Touch: A Pilots Tale in World War II



This is the story of a medical student, Harry Nelson, who postpones his training to become a pilot in the RAF in 1936. Throughout his service his superiors find it advantageous to turn a blind eye to his exploits (The Nelson Touch). These vary from an illegal but necessary medical operation at Aden to rescuing a friend without permission and helping Italian soldiers in the desert which brings unwelcome attention from a senior officer. Then follows an unauthorised raid on enemy lines and finally the instigation of a makeshift force to combat numerically superior Iraqi forces which attack the RAF base at Habbanyia in 1941.
